subject verb placement exercise

Revise the following phrases and sentences, according to the principle of subject verb placement.

That the role of soil microbes in contributing to plant establishment, growth and drought-tolerance when growing under water-stress conditions occurs through nutritional, physiological and cellular effects has been known for a long time (Jones and Flobberblaster 2005).

The most interesting of the growth-promoting soil fungi, *Trichoderma*, a usually aggressive colonizer that can be readily cultured, added to potting media and caused to infect plant roots, has been found to be effective in reduction of rooting time of *Chrysanthemum* cuttings.

Ivermectin, a systemic antiparasitic drug effective against a number of arthropod parasites and gastrointestinal nematodes in cattle, is metabolized very little by treated animals regardless of administration method used. Most of the drug is excreted in the feces in concentrations decreasing daily after treatment.
